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### 4. Principal's Report

The Principal's Report was presented by the Principal:

- Various graduation events have taken place, including the Grad photos and a "Movie Night".
- Students attended various field trips.
- A "Twins" thematic day was held on February 21<sup>st</sup> where students were invited to dress alike.
- The second term report card was issued, and parent-teacher interviews were held on February 27<sup>th</sup> by invitation only.
- In recognition of Black History Month, an assembly on diversity was held in February.
- During the week of February 10<sup>th</sup>, Dunrae held activities as part of Hooked on School Days, an initiative to support perseverance and staying in school.
- The Grade 6 students are working on a Sustainability Project, which will continue until June.
- Teacher Appreciation Week was held during the week of February 24<sup>th</sup>. The Principal thanked the parent community and the DGFA for their generous gifts, including baked goods and a catered lunch and dinner.
- Grade 4 vaccinations will take place in April.
- On March 17<sup>th</sup>, author Lydia Lukidis gave a presentation to Cycle 2 students on the writing process as part of the Culture in School program.
- On March 14<sup>th</sup>, a "Camp Day" was held where students were invited to bring blankets, flashlights and a book to enjoy reading in class.
- On March 21<sup>st</sup>, *Bibite Mobile* came to Dunrae to present various insects and critters to the Pre-school students.
- Students in Dunrae's various enrichment programs will be participating in competitions in April and May, including the Global Issues team, Let's Talk Science, Battle of the Books, the Debate team and Caribou Math.
- Dunrae will be hosting a Kindergarten graduation on June 16<sup>th</sup>.
- April 28<sup>th</sup> has been declared a Ped Day due to the Federal elections. The Ped Day tentatively scheduled for June 2<sup>nd</sup> is cancelled since we lost two school days due to snowstorms.

### 7.2. DGFA Report

Mary Kyres presented on behalf of the DGFA. The DGFA hosted various successful activities over the course of the last two months. On February 14<sup>th</sup>, students participated in a Valentine's Day dance party. During the week of February 24<sup>th</sup>, the DGFA organized treats and gifts for Teacher Appreciation Week. On March 27<sup>th</sup>, hot chocolate was served at recess time. The ECA program is going very well. ### 7.3. PPO Report

Kelly Chatzis presented on behalf of the PPO and provided updates on the following matters:

### School shed

Dunrae was interested in building an outdoor shed to store recess toys/sports equipment. A parent has been assisting with the architectural plans and the paperwork for the City permit. This project has been put on hold due to the potential high costs involved. The school is now exploring purchasing large plastic storage bins to store the toys and equipment.

### Uniform

Dunrae is examining the option of adding a navy or grey top to the uniform. Parents and teachers have commented on the fact that the white polos get dirty very easily. The school is also looking to add some type of hoodie or crew neck sweater.

With respect to the school logo on the uniforms, Dunrae will not be supplying the crest. Parents can purchase the uniform with the school logo from our supplier Top Marks or at the DGFA used uniform sales, or alternatively, obtain the school crest elsewhere if they prefer.

Mme Noémie presented on behalf of the Marketing Committee.

In recognition of Pink Shirt Day, Dunrae invited actress, poet and singer Samara O'Gorman to Dunrae to speak to students about treating others the way you want to be treated. CTV news was present at the event as well as EMSB's Marketing and Communications Manager, Michael Cohen.

In March, a judo activity was organized for Grade 2 students by Dunrae parent and former Judo National Team member Bianca Ockedahl.

On March 31<sup>st</sup>, Dunrae alumni and owner of *Bernie Beignes*, Dean Giannarakis, was at Dunrae to speak about careers and entrepreneurism.

Dunrae has launched its lunchtime chess club.

On May 16<sup>th</sup>, Dunrae will be offering tours of the school to new and prospective parents.
